## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS Week of July 3, 2022

This week's discussion questions are based on the  
First Reading found at Isaiah 66:10-14c, on the  
Second Reading found at Galatians 6:14-18 and on the  
Gospel found at Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

- ✚ The First Reading says, “. . . as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you; in Jerusalem you shall find your comfort.” Compare Jerusalem in this reading with the Church today. What treasure has the Church received from God that gives her children (you) such great comfort?
- ✚ In the Second Reading, St. Paul said, “May I never boast except in the cross.” That means we should constantly deflect credit from ourselves back to God who should receive all the glory. Are there any subtle ways that you may try to get praise or credit from others? Are there other things about which you are tempted to boast?
- ✚ What are some ways that you give glory to God?
- ✚ In the Second Reading, St. Paul also says, “For neither does circumcision mean anything, nor does uncircumcision.” Some people wanted to follow the ancient practices. Paul did not. Can you relate to this kind of problem whether in your home, your work, etc.?
- ✚ In the Gospel, Jesus says “Whatever town you enter and they do not receive you, go out into the streets and say, “The dust of your town that clings to our feet, even that we shake off against you.” How did you react the last time someone opposed, mistreated, or rejected you? What is the condition of your heart towards that person(s) now?
